



Day Camp 2-Go!

The CoVid-19 pandemic has changed the way we work, socially interact, and view the world. In response to congregations/communities who were planning on hosting a Sugar Creek Day Camp Summer 2020, but are now unable to, we are proposing the following to continue our partnership in spreading the Gospel and fostering faith in young hearts.

The goals of this at-home program are...

1. Engage youth where they are by helping them encounter Christ, experience God's grace, and be empowered by the Holy Spirit to go forth in faith.
2. Be a resource for congregations in this time of CoVid-19 by providing life-giving youth programming.
3. Inspire hope in a bleak and trying time.

- **Church is responsible for...**

- Registration of Campers
- Purchasing of Craft Supplies
- Assembly of Take-home bags/sacks
- Delivering bags/sacks to campers (drive-thru pick-up at Church)

- **Sugar Creek is responsible for...**

- Recording, editing, and producing a series of videos to correspond with each day of Day Camp. Each daily video series will be approximately 20-minutes of video content.
- Hiring and training of staff to be counselors for the videos
- Providing list of craft supplies and other Take-home bag contents
- The videos will have the following general outline
 - Introduction
 - Song (Singing and Dancing!)
 - Bible story
 - *Curriculum is adapted from ELCA World Hunger VBS Resource "On Earth as in Heaven"*
 - Skit
 - Message
 - Prayer
 - Craft w/explanation
 - Creation Challenge/Sending





Answers to Questions you may have

- **How much does this cost?**

- We are using a 3-tiered pricing model, much like we do for on-site camper registrations. The program is the same regardless of which tier is selected.

Tier 1: \$1,200 *minimum base-cost for SCBC Day Camp Team

Tier 2: \$300 *Cost of Deposit for SCBC Day Camp Team

Tier 3: \$0

- Because we know that some congregations are struggling financially in these times, we have made a commitment to make this program available to anyone who may find use in it.
- Tier 2 covers the cost to employ one summer staff for a week
- Tier 1 covers the cost to employ four summer staff for a week

- **How do we get the bags to campers?**

- We encourage congregations to do what they are comfortable with and makes sense for them. One option we would like to offer would be a “drive-thru” pick-up. The steps are below.

1. Assemble bags
2. Schedule a time to have the bag pick-up
3. Communicate time with families
4. Have volunteers in PPE (Masks and Gloves are good, having an apron and goggles is even better) handout bags as campers/parents drive-thru
5. Campers arrive at home and use the at-home resource to guide them to the corresponding videos
6. Have fun!

- **When would this be available?**

- We plan to begin filming on June 1, and to be completed with post-production by June 14. This was the original start date for our summer program 2020. This means that you can still hold a day camp program in your community, the original week you were planning too! But you can do it anytime you wish because the video program will always be available.
- You can use the crafts material list from this resource to begin preparing for this program now!


1. Full Size Ivory Soap Bar

8. Black marker.





Day 1: ZERO HUNGER



Petition: “Give us today our daily bread.”

Bible story: Feeding of the 5,000 (Matt 14:13-21)

Message: God gives us everything we need. When we share what we have, there is enough for everyone.

Craft: Basket of Fish and Bread

- Materials: Scissors, Colored Pencils or Crayons, stick Glue, Craft Template, 1 sheet of construction paper.
- Instructions:
 1. Color Fish, Bread, and Basket
 2. Use Scissors to cut out each piece
 3. Glue the fish and loaves behind the basket in a random order
 4. Glue the whole thing onto a piece of construction paper
 5. Cut out the whole figure
 6. Write “Give us today our daily bread.” On the back

Creation Challenge: See how God provides

1. Go outside!
2. Scatter some bird seed or breadcrumbs on the ground
3. Find a place at least 20 feet away and watch
4. Note which animals you see who eat the seed you scattered
5. Read Matthew 6: 26-27 (Birds of the Air)
 - a. Because God provides for the animals, we can trust that he will provide for us.



Day 1: ZERO HUNGER

Bible story: Feeding of the 5,000 (Matt 14:13-21)



Questions for the Bible story

- What did the people need?
- Why did the disciples tell Jesus to send the people away?
- What did Jesus tell the disciples to do?
- How would you have felt if you were a disciple and Jesus told you to feed the crowd with the five loaves and two fish?
- How do you think the disciples felt when they fed the whole crowd?

Lord's Prayer: "Give us today our daily bread"

Questions for Lord's Prayer Petition

- What sort of things might be included in "daily bread"?
 - What are the things we need each day to be happy, healthy and safe?
- Who helps you get your "daily bread"?
- What are ways you can help others get their "daily bread"?

Prayer of the Day:

Dear God, thank you for giving us everything we need and friends and family to share with. Help us, if we need help, to be able to ask and, if we have something to share, to be able to share it with each other. Amen.



Day 2: GOOD HEALTH

Petition: “Your will be done, on earth as in heaven.”

Bible story: Jesus heals the paralyzed man (Luke 5: 17-26)

Message: God can use us to heal each other.

Craft: Soap Carving

Source: 2020 ELCA World Hunger VBS Resource

- Materials: Full-size soap bar (Ivory works well), Craft stick
- Instructions:
 1. Using the craft stick carve a heart, or other symbol of love on one side of the soap
 2. Go outside and put your hands in the mud or dirt
 3. Go wash your hands with your Love Soap
 4. Just as water and the soap cleans your hands, God’s love and the water of your baptism cleans your heart, so that you can share love.

Creation Challenge: Alphabet Scavenger Hunt

1. Go outside!
2. Starting with the letter A, find something in nature that begins with each letter of the alphabet.
3. Write what you find on the Scavenger Hunt Sheet!
4. God has created a ton of cool things.
5. After using the backside of the Scavenger Hunt Sheet for tomorrow’s Craft “Special Places”, mail both sides completed to Sugar Creek to show us what you found!



Day 2: GOOD HEALTH

Bible story: Jesus heals the paralyzed Man (Luke 5: 17-26)



Questions for the Bible story

- Why couldn't the men get their friend to Jesus?
- What did they do to solve the problem?
- Have you ever tried to help someone and discovered that you didn't know how?
- Did someone help you solve the problem?
- What are some ways you might help someone who needs healing?

Lord's Prayer: "Your will be done, on Earth as in Heaven"

Questions for Lord's Prayer Petition

- What are some things that you think God wants for everyone in the world?
- How do you think God can use you to do some things that are part of God's will for the world?
 - How might God use us to help other people be happy and healthy?

Prayer of the Day:

Dear God, thank you for your will for the world and for all the people you created to do your will. Help us be open today to seeing the ways that you are using us to bring healing and hope to each other and the world. Amen.



Day 3: EDUCATION



Petition: “Hallowed be your name.”

Bible story: Jesus sends the disciples (Luke 9:1-6, 10-11)

Message: Jesus taught the disciple so they could share in Jesus’ own work.
Each of us has things to learn and things we can teach each other.

Craft: Special Places

- Materials: Special Place Paper, Colored Pencils.
- Instructions:
 1. Go outside and find a place to sit and draw.
 2. Using a blank piece of paper and coloring utensils, draw your favorite place in nature.
 3. When you are done ask yourself “how would you feel if this place was trashed and ruined?” “If you could stop it would you?”
 4. What can we do to make sure that places like the one you drew will not be ruined?
 5. God calls us to care for nature and creation.

Creation Challenge: See God’s work

1. Find a spot on the grass outside
2. Sit with legs straight on ground
3. Look at the grass around you, how many plants can you count around you?
4. How many animals?
5. How are they connected?
6. Is there life you cannot see?
7. God’s creation is wonderful, and you are a part of it.



Day 3: EDUCATION

Bible story: Jesus sends the disciples (Luke 9: 1-6, 10-11)



Questions for the Bible story

- When you have learned a new thing, how did you learn it?
- When you are trying to share something you know with someone else, how do you teach that person?
- How did the disciples learn from Jesus?
- Who teaches you new things?
- How do you learn about Jesus?
- How do you think the disciples felt when Jesus sent them out to do what he'd taught them?
- How do you think they felt when they came back and shared all that they had done?

Lord's Prayer: "Hallowed be your name"

Questions for Lord's Prayer Petition

- Hallowed means to be holy or set apart. To be holy or set apart means to be a special part of God's work in the world.
 - What is your favorite toy or stuffed animal?
 - Do you remember where you got it?
 - What makes it special?
- Each of us are special to God, set apart to be part of God's work in the world.

Prayer of the Day:

Thank you, God, for giving us so much to learn and so much we can teach. Help us to be open, to share what we know and to learn from each other, so that we can share your love with the world. Amen.



Day 4: PEACE



Petition: “For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever. Amen.”

Bible story: Jesus appears to the disciples (Luke 24: 36-49)

Message: God loves us and everyone in the world and that God is always with us.

Craft: Handprint Peace Dove

- Materials: Construction paper: Blue, white, green, brown, yellow; glue stick, scissors, black marker.
- Instructions:
 1. With four fingers together and the thumb stretched away, trace a handprint onto the white paper. The fingers and palm make the body and wings while the thumb is the dove’s head
 2. Cut out the handprint and glue it to the blue paper.
 3. Draw curved lines to make the wing.
 4. Draw a dot for the eye.
 5. Cut out a small beak out of the yellow construction paper.
 6. Glue the beak onto the face of the dove.
 7. Cut out an olive branch from the green paper and glue it to the beak.
 8. Cut out a strip of the brown paper to make a branch. Glue it below the dove.
 9. Draw the dove’s legs and claws latching onto the branch.
 10. Write the word “Peace” on the page and display!


Creation Challenge: Nature Yoga

1. Find a flat spot outside
2. Hold the following poses for 30 seconds each: Tree, Frog, and Seed.
3. While holding the poses, imagine you are those plants or animal.
4. Just like those things we acted as; we are a part of nature. What animals and plants are we close too? Do we share space with?



Day 4: PEACE

Bible story: Jesus appears to the disciples (Luke 24: 36-49)



Questions the Bible story

- What do you think peace means?
- Why do you think Jesus said, “Peace be with you”?
- The disciples were surprised, and even a little scared when they saw Jesus. The last time they saw Jesus he was dead on the cross. When was a time that you were scared?
- How does Jesus help them not be scared?
- How can we help other people not be scared or sad? How can we help them be “at peace”?

Lord’s Prayer: “For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are yours, now and forever. Amen.”

Questions for Lord’s Prayer Petition

- The end of the Lord’s Prayer reminds us that, whatever we pray for, we can trust that God loves us, that God is always with us, and that everything and everyone belongs to God.
- What are some challenges the world faces that we can pray for?
- What are some ways God is at work in the world through us?
- How can you see that God at work every day?

Prayer of the Day:

Dear God, thank you for giving us everything we need and friends and family to share with. Help us, if we need help, to be able to ask and, if we have something to share, to be able to share it with each other. Amen.
